





Culture fusion is a major theme of Huang Yu Long's sculptures. *N.S.E.W* adopts street culture, including graffiti, street dance, DJ remix, Rapping to mix with images of Four Greatest Heavenly Guardians who watch over four cardinal directions "North, East, South, and West" of the world in Buddhism mythology. Four Greatest Heavenly Guardians in nowadays are put on hoodie outfits, playing recorded music as DJs, making graffiti and dancing street dances in the street. Four guardians of street culture represent leading positions in contemporary culture and they also express the artist's tribute to street culture.


