Soon after, in 2014, he decided to quit and open his own art shop at Chatuchak Market in Bangkok.

It wasn't easy for him to start and manage the shop on his own. He had been trying so hard to create the outstanding and memorable work to get people to know that this is Yuttana's work and finally he figures out that he wanted to create the work that relates to his personality. Therefore, the best way to describe him and his works precisely is "Simplicity".

Yuttana enjoyed every moment in his everyday life ever since and most of his time are devoted to his true passion. Each painting of his would usually take up to 2 to 4 weeks to complete, but also depending on the details of the painting, as Yuttana is very keen with his works during every process and aspect in each paintings he created, to ensure that every piece meets the highest standards.








